Light Garden

The light garden is illuminated by reflections from a wall of windows, configured according to principals learned from studying the cut of a diamond. Reflections of light into the garden shift and wink as the sun moves across the sky. A low wall on the south edge of the garden casts a shadow over it, its depth varying over the course of the day. The shadow intensifies the light effect of the reflections. Inside, a simple hall also benefits from the light effects. Transmitted light is intensified and refracted by various angles of the glass panes. Night lighting makes an inverse effect.
